

Paul Grant on the 30th Anniversary of “Woodstock in Physics”

On the occasion of the 30th anniversary of the APS March Meeting 1987, which has been dubbed “Woodstock in Physics”, [Paul Grant](#), formerly of IBM and later EPRI, wrote some reminiscences on how high-temperature superconductivity was discovered & announced, including the insufficiently known fact that Bednorz and Müller themselves reported on the Meissner effect in their cuprate samples even before it was done by the Tanaka group in Tokyo.
