Named in honor of Dr. Gifford, co-inventor of the Gifford-McMahon cycle and founder of Cryomech, Inc., the William E. Gifford Award is given to a recipient in academia or a government laboratory using a pulse tube or Gifford-McMahon cycle cryocooler as a key research component.

A person of distinction in cryogenics, who has made notable valuable contributions to the field.

The Robert W. Vance Award was established to honor persons for their dedication and long-term commitment to the advancement of CSA.
